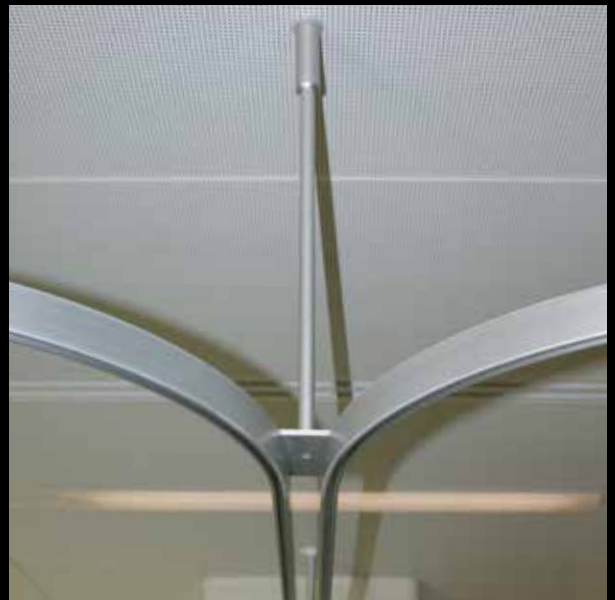
Tailored solutions

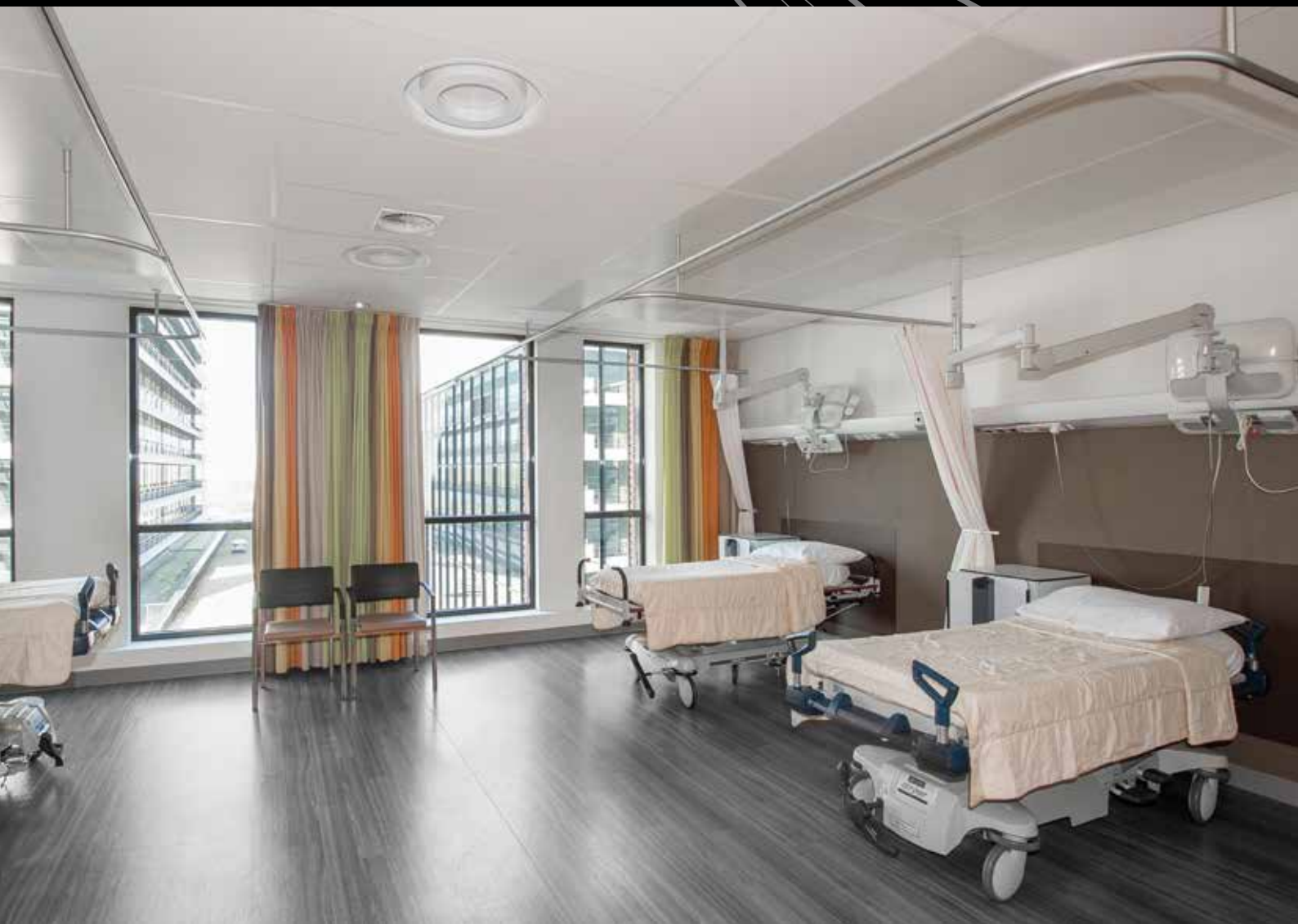
